Mr. Otis Farmer Jr., age 88, of Lyons died Saturday, December 23, 2017, at Community Hospice of Vidalia after an extended illness. Otis was born in Swainsboro on May 19, 1929. He served one tour of duty as a cook in the United States Army, and also worked as an ironworker traveling the east coast.
