Mr. Hudman "Hub" Mock, age 95, of Mt. Vernon died Wednesday, August 2, 2017 at Community Hospice of Vidalia after a brief illness. He was a native of Dover GA, resided in Savannah for many years, and retired to Mt. Vernon in 1975. He retired from the United States Army as a Command Sgt. Major with 21 years of service. He was a veteran of World War II and Korea where he received numerous awards including the Purple Heart.
